



### **Show conditions for qualifying events for the World Reining Championship**

Competition open to the NRHA Affiliates and/or National federations members all over the world.

Riders and owners must be current NRHA members, horses must have a NRHA competition license.

For all the categories, the horses must be 5 years old and over.

- Qualification period for the 2025 World Reining Championship is from January 1, 2025, to May 26, 2025.

It is the rider who qualifies, and the horse ridden during the qualification does not necessarily have to be the one that will take part in the World Reining Championship 2025, although the minimum score for each division must be achieved.

- **68 or multiples if 2, 3 or more judges (136, 204) for Junior riders**
- **70 or multiples if 2, 3 or more judges (140, 210) for Young Non-Professional riders**
- **70 or multiples if 2, 3 or more judges (140, 210) for Young Professional riders**
- **70 or multiples if 2, 3 or more judges (140, 210) for Senior Non-Professional riders**
- **71 or multiples if 2, 3 or more judges (142, 213) for Senior Professional riders**
- **70 or multiples if 2, 3 or more judges (140, 210) for Prime-Time Non-Professional riders**

Each rider can participate in as many WR classes as they wish.

They can also participate in events abroad.

Each rider will be able to enter the number of horses that the NRHA class authorizes.

Each nation will make its final selection of teams and individual riders for the World Reining Championship 2025

**Wildcard's will be given to the top 5 Non-Pro and Open NRHA riders 2024 and to the NRHA million dollars riders, all the other riders will have to ride one time the minimum score on an approved World Reining event to be qualified.**



## **Divisions definitions.**

**Junior Riders:** Any person from the year in which they reach the age of 14 until the year in which they reach the age of 18 is allowed to take part in Junior Reining competitions.

Qualifying classes must be held class in class with NRHA Approved Youth classes.

**Minimum score 68 or multiples if 2, 3 or more judges (136, 204).**

**Young Non-Professional Riders:** Any person having a NRHA Non-Pro status from the year in which they reach the age of **18** until the year in which they reach the age of **25** is allowed to take part in Reining competitions for Young Non-Professional Riders. Qualifying classes can be held class in class with NRHA-approved Non-Pro classes.

**Minimum Score 70 or multiples if 2, 3 or more judges (140, 210).**

**Young Professional Riders:** Any person from the year in which they reach the age of **18** until the year in which they reach the age of **25** is allowed to take part in Reining competitions for Young Professional Riders. Qualifying classes can be held class in class with NRHA-approved Open classes.

**Minimum Score 70 or multiples if 2, 3 or more judges (140, 210).**

**Senior Non-Professional Riders:** Any person which is a Non-Professional rider (as define by NRHA rules) and a person from the year in which they reach their **26th** birthday is allowed to take part in Senior Non-Professional Riders competitions.

Qualifying classes must be held class in class, with NRHA Approved Non-Pro classes.

**Minimum Score 70 or multiples if 2, 3 or more judges (140, 210).**

**Senior Professional Riders:** Any person from the year in which they reach their **26th** birthday is allowed to take part in Senior Professional Riders competitions.

Qualifying classes must be held class in class, with NRHA Approved Open classes.

**Minimum Score 71 or multiples if 2, 3 or more judges (142, 213).**

**Prime time Non-Professional Riders:** Any person which is a Non-Professional rider (as define by NRHA rules) and a person from the year in which they reach their **50th** birthday is allowed to take part in Prime-time Non-Professional Riders competitions.

Qualifying classes must be held class in class, with NRHA Approved Prime time Non-Pro or Non-Pro classes.

**Minimum Score 70 or multiples if 2, 3 or more judges (140, 210).**
